Varietal Content

99% Cabernet Sauvignon, 1% Petit Verdot

The 2019 McGah Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is brooding, complex and beautiful. Amazingly intense aromatics showcase layers of black cassis, red fruits, graham cracker and earthy/dusty components known for this terroir. The mid palate is perfectly balanced with massive amounts of blue and black fruits, followed with a full-bodied and buoyant mouthfeel that hovers across the spectrum of the palate. Perfectly integrated structure and polished tannins lead to a detailed and long finish that our sails off into Cabernet Sauvignon supernova. A blend from five of our Cabernet Sauvignon blocks on the Rutherford estate, this wine showcases the unparalleled terroir of the McGah Vineyard. Allow 2-3 years for the tannins and fruit to come together or enjoy it in its prime 5-10 years out.

Processing Information

Process: : 5-day cold soak and fermented for 16-18 days. Free run and pressed juice are then combined and put into barrels without settling.

Barrel Aging: 80% new French oak consisting of Darnajou, Taransaud, Marcel Cadet, Remond, Trueil and Sylvain barrels
